IDP Subgroup Postdoctoral Research Awards

Note deadline of **November 6, 2009**.

Awards will be made to two postdoctoral scholars/fellows for outstanding research in the field of *intrinsically disordered proteins*. Awardees will each receive a US\$500 honorarium and present a short talk at the IDP Subgroup Symposium on Saturday February 20, 2010, in San Francisco (held in conjunction with the 2010 Biophysical Society Annual Meeting).

To be considered for these awards, postdoctoral scholars/fellows must:

- Submit an abstract for a poster and/or talk to be presented at the Biophysical Society Annual Meeting. Select “Intrinsically Disordered Proteins” as a topic area (this can be submitted as a “Late Abstract”).
- Send the abstract via email directly to the IDP Subgroup at IDPsubgroup@gmail.com by **November 6, 2009**.
- Have their advisor email the Subgroup at IDPsubgroup@gmail.com by **November 6, 2009** confirming the postdoctoral status of the applicant. To be eligible for an award, postdoctoral scholars/fellows must be in that status at the time of abstract submission.

The selection committee will choose the top two abstracts from those submitted on the basis of scientific quality and diversity with respect to the topics to be discussed by the other invited speakers.
